1. The Schools Division of Kabankalan City will conduct the **2020 Division YES-O Camp** at **Florentino Galang Sr. National High School**, Brgy. Orong, Kabankalan City on **February 6-8, 2020** with the theme: **Yes-One Para sa Kalikasan**.

2. The camp has the following objectives:

4. Registration fee is intended for the materials, electricity, sound, honoraria of the various resource speakers and is chargeable to local funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
5. Participants are requested to bring their own beddings and eating utensils.
6. Enclosed are the guidelines of the contests, registration form, and program matrix.
7. Division YES-O Officers and facilitators are expected to be at the venue a day before until the last day of the camp.
8. Advisers are responsible for the welfare and safety of the student participants under their guidance and care. Compliance with DepEd Order No. 66, s. 2017 on the conduct of off-campus activities shall be strictly observed.

Theme: "YES-One as Kalikasan"

JINGLE FOR THE ENVIRONMENT

(secondary)

OBJECTIVES	To showcase the student's care and love for the environment through their creative and musical skills.
No. of Required Participants	10-15 participants per participating school
Composition	Any grade level
Duration of the performance	3-5 minutes
Rules and Guidelines	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. The lyrics must be originally written in Filipino and must be theme-based. Adaptation of melody is allowed.2. Acapella is allowed or any musical instrument can be used as accompaniment.3. Instrumentalists are included as participants.4. No pyro techniques allowed.5. There will be no choreography during performance. Hand movements are allowed.6. Student-participants only.7. Performance is 3-5 minutes only. One-point deduction will be made for every 30-seconds exceeded.8. Participants should wear their school YES-O t-shirt only.9. Lyrics in four (4) copies should be submitted during the registration.10. The judges' decision is final and irrevocable.

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YES-O RAP

Rules and Guidelines	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Must be original composition written in English or Filipino and must be theme-based. 2. No musical instruments should be used. 3. Participants must be composed of vocalist(s) and a beat boxer(s) 4. Attire should be decent. 5. The lyrics must be submitted in four (4) copies during the registration. 6. The judges' decision is final and irrevocable.
Criteria	Melody -----30% Lyrical Content -----30% Harmony -----30% Mastery -----10% Total -----100%

ENVIRO QUIZ
 (Elementary & Secondary)

OBJECTIVES	To assess and evaluate the learner's ideas and concepts and environmental issues and concerns.
No. of Required Participants	One (1) team per school composed of six (6) members coming from every grade level
Duration of the performance	3 hours
Rules and Guidelines	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. There shall be three main rounds: EASY, AVERAGE, and DIFFICULT 2. Five questions will be given for every round observing the following points: Easy – 1 point, Average – 2 pts, Difficult – 3 pts, Clincher – sudden death 3. In case of tie after the summation of all points across the 3 rounds, clincher round will be given to determine the top 3 winners observing the sudden death system. 4. There will be no substitution of participants. 5. The judges' decision is final and irrevocable.



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RECYCLING SHOWCASE
 (Elementary & Secondary)

Composition	2 participants per recyclable material type
Needed Materials	<p>A. PLASTIC BOTTLES: Plastic bottles per category, glue gun and glue sticks, extension cords, pair of scissors, and abaca string</p> <p>B. STYROFOAM: Styrofoam (use of leftovers), glue gun and glue sticks and other related materials</p> <p>C. TIN CANS: tin cans and other related materials. Electrical connections (extension wires). Weighing scale (for excess materials)</p> <p>D. TARPULIN: tarpaulin, scissors, glue, etc.</p>
Duration of performance	3 hours
Rules and Guidelines	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The participants shall be grouped according to the type of recyclable materials. 2. Strictly NO COMMERCIAL PAINT allowed. 3. Only the participants are allowed in the contest venue. 4. Participants must maximize the use of recyclable materials. The mass leftover materials will be determined. The following points will be deducted from the participants after the time allotted: 10% of the mass left-over -----5 points 15% of the mass left-over -----7 points 20% of the mass left-over -----10 points 5. Pre-assembled accessories are not allowed. 6. The judges' decision is final and irrevocable.

Rules and Guidelines	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The poster should revolve around the theme which will be announced by the contest administrator during the contest proper. 2. The required base paper to be used during the contest is illustration board. 3. All materials except the illustration board will be provided by the contestant. Borrowing of materials from other contestant is not allowed. 4. At the option of the contestant, she/he may use pencil to draft sketches of his/her concept. 5. The allotted time for the contestant is 2 hours, after which all entries shall be submitted to the contest administrator. Contestant may decide to submit his/her poster earlier without waiting for the lapse of two hours. 6. Each poster shall be identified by a number that corresponds to the number and identity of the contestant for judges purpose.

The photos must be displayed in the exhibit area with respective contestants to explain in front of the panel of judges the clear and identifiable message in the photo within three-minute time. Overtime should be deducted 1 pt. per minute from the overall grades and entry. 3. The contest coordinator shall assign one official developing center for the contestant to develop their photo in 8R (8"x11" size). 4. The facilitator will see to it that SD card of the cameras are empty before the contest.

Rules and Guidelines	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Various situations relating to disaster risk reduction and management shall be the theme of all performances. 2. Situations will be drawn out to each group 5 minutes before each performance 3. The committee through the Technical Working Group will provide the materials for students' props which will be distributed day before the performance. 4. Any additional materials not provided by the committee shall be subject to disqualification. 5. Background music is NOT allowed. However, performers may create human sounds as part of their performance. 6. Any vulgar words and actions used during a performance shall also be subject to immediate stoppage by the organizers. 7. Participants will wear only their respective YES-O shirts. 8. Performance duration shall start as soon as one or any of the performers stepped on the stage. 9. A performance shall end once the last participant has stepped out of the performance area. 10. One (1) point deduction form the average score will be made for every 30 second exceeded 11.
