WHO ARE NOT QUALIFIED TO JOIN

- Teachers who have previous or pending administrative, civil or criminal cases
- Teachers who were prosecuted in any civil or criminal cases
- Teachers who were suspended, reprimanded, or sanctioned for violation of any administrative policies

Evaluation of Nominations by the Screening Committee	<p>The Screening Committee evaluates the nomination forms based on the criteria and determines the short-listed nominees.</p>
Validation and Interview / Establishment of Profile / Background Check	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Short-listed nominees are contacted and an interview is scheduled. 2. The interview validates the qualification of the nominee and establishes his/her profile. 3. Based on the results of the interview and background check, the Screening Committee selects the finalists.
Selection of Honorees	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. From the finalists, the Board of Judges selects the honorees to represent this year's The Many Faces of the Teacher.
