
DIVISION MEMORANDUM

DIVISION CULMINATION ON THE OBSERVANCE OF THE FILIPINO VALUES MONTH

TO: Assistant Schools Division Superintendent

1. Presidential Proclamation No. 479 dated October 24, 1994 stipulates that the Filipino Values Month is celebrated every November of each year. The celebration aims to strengthen the Filipino culture, values and ideas that are MakaDiyos, Makatao, Makakalikasan at Makabansa. Furthermore, it hopes to mobilize all Filipinos for nation-building through the practical exercise of human values in daily lives as citizens, and to awaken all of the power of these values and ideals in achieving the individual and national goals.
2. In line with this, the Schools Division Office of Kabankalan City enjoins all schools to participate actively in the observance of the Filipino Values Month with the theme "Pamilyang Pilipino Patatagin: Susi sa Paghubog ng Kabataang Maka-Diyos, Makatao, Makakalikasan at Makabansa".
3. All school heads are encouraged to spearhead the celebration through their respective school EsP coordinators through advocacy campaign like posting of tarpaulin and giving of pamphlets about different Filipino Values. Furthermore, the observance of the Filipino Values Month will culminate through the conduct of Division EsP Contests on November 29, 2019, 8:00 a.m. – 12:00 nn at Florentino Galang, Sr. National High School, District of Kabankalan V. (See Enclosure for the Committees and the Criteria and Guidelines for the Contests.).
4. The schools shall submit to the Curriculum Implementation Division the school consolidated report that captures the impact of the activity/ celebration.
5. Travel and other miscellaneous expenses relative to the conduct of the said activities shall be charged to local funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
6. Immediate and wide dissemination of the Memorandum is desired.

GUIDELINES AND CRITERIA to the DIVISION EsP CONTESTS


A. TAGIS-TALINO (JHS/Elementary)

1. The contestants from each district will be two teams with two contestants per team (a total of 4) preferably from Grades 8,9, or 10 in the Junior High School and also two teams from Grades 4 , 5 or 6 in the elementary. They are the first and second placers during their District Elimination.
2. The coverage of the test will be from Grade 8 to 10 in the Junior High School and Grades 4 to 6 in the elementary level.
3. The teams will compete in three rounds:
 - Easy round - 1 point each
 - Average Round - 3 points each
 - Difficult round - 5 points each
4. Contestants shall be in school uniform with identification card.
5. The Quizmaster will read the questions twice and the team will be given fifteen (15) seconds to write the answer on the illustration board, then wait for the quizmaster's signal to raise the answer. The scorers will check the responses and tally the scores on the scoreboard.
6. In case of a tie, the quizmaster will ask a new set of questions with 5 points each correct answer. The team with the highest score or who can score 15 first will automatically be declared as the winner.
7. There will be five questions per category that relates to the contents of EsP 8, 9, and 10 subjects and for Grades 4 to 6 lessons (cover to cover).
8. The three teams with the highest scores will be declared as winners (1st, 2nd, 3rd).

B. On -the-SPOT POSTER-MAKING CONTEST

1. Contestants are advised to bring their own materials.
 - ❖ ¼ illustration board, white
 - ❖ Pastel, water color, crayons, sign pen, pencils can be used as medium
 - ❖ Use of pentel pen is prohibited.
2. The poster must be related to the theme " Pamilyang Pilipino Patatagin: Susi sa Paghubog ng Kabataang MakaDiyos, Makatao, MakaKalikasan at Makabansa".
3. Contestants are given three (3) hours to finish the work.
4. Lettering and borders are NOT allowed as part of the presentation.
5. The criteria for judging are the following:

❖ Creativity & Artistry	-	25%
❖ Originality	-	25%
❖ Relevance to the theme	-	30%
❖ Visual Impact	-	20%
Total	-	100%



C. STORYTELLING CONTEST (Elementary)

1. Piece should focus on positive values not on violence, murder, reversion, abortion or rape.
2. Material should be read and not to exceed five (5) minutes. One point shall be deducted from the total score for every 1 minute exceeded.
3. The storyteller should minimize gestures but must focus on facial expressions.
4. The storyteller has the option to sit down or to stand during his/her performance.
5. Attire must be decent and presentable. Props are not allowed.
6. Criteria for Judging:

❖ Interpretation, characterization & facial expression	-	50%
❖ Voice modulation & gestures	-	15%
❖ Diction (pronunciation, enunciation, stress)	-	20%
❖ Suitability of the piece	-	10%
❖ Stage Presence	-	5%
