DIVISION YEAR END PROGRAM IMPLEMENTATION REVIEW ON SIX FLAGSHIP PROGRAMS OF OPLAN KALUSUGAN SA DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION (OK sa DepEd)

Relative to the thrust of the Government and pursuant to DepEd Order No. 28, s. 2018, otherwise known as the Policy and Guidelines on Oplan Kalusugan sa Department of Education which ensures the welfare of the Learners, the Schools Division Office of Kabankalan City strengthens the implementation of Oplan Kalusugan sa Department of Education through its Six Flagship programs which warrant the efficiency of school health programs in improving the health status and helping our learners reach their full educational potential and better productivity for our personnel.

2. This activity aims to:

- a. Ensure and evaluate the implementation of OK sa DepEd Six Flagship programs;
- b. Further assess the health needs of learners and personnel;
- Harmonize identified health gaps with standard health practice and provision of Technical Assistance;
- d. Ensure all learners and DepEd personnel practice healthier behaviour that they can do on their own;
- e. Identify gender sensitive health practices; and
- f. Assess collaboration with various partners and stakeholders especially at the school level for continued support and partnership towards a gender sensitive environment.

- On December 6, 2019, all schools are hereby enjoined to send their OK sa DepEd school Focal person to attend the above mentioned activity at XARIS function. The program shall start at 8:00AM with snack as the first meal.
- 4. All OK sa DepEd school focal shall prepare a soft copy report and power point presentation using the OK sa DepEd reporting form C with pictures supporting the activities conducted. The soft copy report shall be submitted on the day of the activity for consolidation. Attached in enclosure A is the template for reporting.
- Food of the participants shall be charged against CSWD-GAD fund, while travel expenses incurred shall be charged to School MOOE, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
