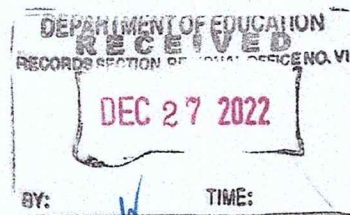

12th PHILIPPINE GEOGRAPHY OLYMPIAD

The Geographic Society of the University of the Philippines (UP GeogSoc), in partnership with the UP Department of Geography and the International Association of Young Geographers (IAYG), will conduct its 12th Philippine Geography Olympiad (PGO) virtually on February 3–5, 2023.

PGO is the premier and largest nationwide geography quiz bee competition for junior and senior high school students. The Olympiad has been an excellent venue for students to showcase their knowledge and understanding in the field of geography through a series of friendly scholastic competitions. It is recognized by the International Geographical Union (IGU) as the country's official national geography competition. The winners of the Olympiad become the official delegates to the annual International Geography Olympiad (iGeo).

Participation of learners and teachers from public and private schools shall be purely voluntary and will not hamper instructional time in compliance with the provisions of DepEd Order (DO) No. 34, s. 2022 titled School Calendar and Activities for the School Year 2022-2023 and DO 9, s. 2005 titled Instituting Measures to Increase Engaged Time-on-Task and Ensuring Compliance Therewith and the policy off-campus activities stated in DO 66, s. 2017.
