- 4. There will be two separate categories for this contest Elementary and High School Category.
- 5. Entry must be an original composition (lyrics and melody) in either English or Filipino arrangement.
- 6. Lyrics should be patterned in this year's Safer Internet Day Theme "Together for a better internet" and on the Cybersafety tips.
- 7. Entries must be recorded on MP4 or WMV video format with subtitle of the song lyrics in the video.
- 8. Entries must be submitted not later than March 10, 2023 for the selection of top five entries, who will be presenting live for final judging during the culmination activity on March 18, 2023 @ City Mall Kabankalan.

MECHANICS/ GUIDELINES

- Contestant is currently enrolled for the school year 2023-2024 in the school he/she represents.
- 2. He/she must be between Grades 5- 12 in that same school.
- 3. All schools (public and private) under the Division may participate. Only one contestant per school.
- 4. There will be two separate categories for this contest Elementary and High School Category.
- 5. Entry must be an original composition in either English, Filipino or Hiligaynon. (The use of Taglish or multi-language/dialect is discouraged if possible).
- 6. The entry must illustrate, interpret, and emphasize this year's Safer Internet Day Theme "Together for a better internet" and on the Cybersafety tips.
- 7. Sounds, instrumental or music background is not required but is allowed to complement the delivery.
- 8. Entries must be recorded on MP4 or WMV video format with subtitle of the lyrics in the video.
- 9. Entries must be submitted not later than March 10, 2023 for the selection of top five entries, who will be presenting live for final judging during the culmination activity on March 18, 2023 @ City Mall Kabankalan.

CRITERIA FOR JUDGING

A. Message/Content -40%

The content of the spoken poetry illustrates, interprets, and emphasizes the theme.

The piece has a powerful and meaningful message to the audience.

B. Delivery and Performance-30%

The spoken piece is delivered as to what emotion is asked in the piece.

Connection to the audience was established from the start.

Facial expression, hand and body gestures emphasized the different elements of the performance.

Eye contact pulled the audience to the message of the spoken words.

Audience's attention and interest were captured and sustained throughout the delivery.

Pronunciation and enunciation sound natural and clear.

C. Originality-30%

The piece must be an original composition of the contestant.
