3. This Office reiterates that participation of learners and teachers in extra-curricular activities is voluntary. The school heads of the participating schools shall take full responsibility in ensuring compliance to DepEd Order No. 9, s. 2005 titled Instituting Measures to Increased Engaged Time-On Task and Ensuring Compliance Therewith and DepEd Order No. 66, s. 2017, re: Implementing Guidelines on the Conduct of Off-Campus Activities.
4. The registration fee of Five-Hundred Pesos (P500.00) that will be collected from each participant is chargeable against the Local Funds/Special Education Fund 2023, while the travel and incidental expenses incurred in participating this activity are chargeable against the School MOOE/Local Funds subject to availability and to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

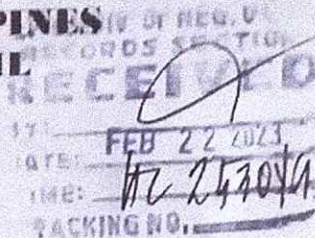

**COUNCIL OFFICE MEMORANDUM**

**TO:** Area / City / Municipal / District Chairmen and Vice Chairmen, City / Municipal / District Scout Commissioners and Field Commissioners, Institutional Heads / Coordinators both Secondary Private and Public Schools within Negros Occidental Council's Territory

**SUBJECT:** **FIRST NEGROS OCCIDENTAL COUNCIL ADVANCEMENT CAMPOREE**

1. Based on the 2023 Council Calendar of Events and Activities as approved by the Council Executive Board during its 1<sup>st</sup> Regular Meeting on 26 January 2023, the 1<sup>st</sup> Negros Occidental Council Advancement Camporee will be conducted on **March 29 to April 02, 2023** at **Himaya Scout Camp & Training Center**, Sitio Bingig, Barangay III, Himamaylan City, Negros Occidental, upon cordial acceptance of Himamaylan City Scouting Committee to host this historic event designed to showcase the Advancement Program of the Council. This will showcase Learning Continuity and very relevant Skills Upgrading of Scouts in the outdoor with the integration of Literacy, Numeracy, 21<sup>st</sup> Century Skills, Values Formation, Environmental Stewardship, Citizenship, and Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs).
2. The Department of Education has recognized Scouting as an **effective co-curricular activity** that complements the classroom learning of students with actual exposure to real world and experiential learning through the outdoors. The present Assistant Secretary, Dr. Dexter A. Galban, Official Representative of DepEd to the Boy Scouts of the Philippines National Executive Board, has encouraged the active participation of learners to various Scouting activities.
3. Thus, to give meaning to the objectives of this Advancement Camporee, all City / Municipal Scouting Committees including Public Elementary and Secondary Schools and Private Schools within the Council's Territory will participate in the first ever Council Advancement Camporee and endeavor to send a maximum participation, if possible, at least 10% of the total registered Boy and Senior Scouts recorded in the Council Office last year 2022. This is to enable registered Scouts in their respective units to avail the Advancement Program that focuses on the priority areas of education such as Literacy, Numeracy and 21<sup>st</sup> Century Skills, Values Formation, Environmental Stewardship, Citizenship, and Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) for Scouts and Adult Leaders, in support of the **MATATAG Roadmap of DepEd**.
4. Among the highlights of the Camporee's Program of Activities during the duration of the events are in line with the DepEd's Advocacy and Program that will be incorporated as specialists rating in Boy Advancement indicated below:

**JAMBORACE**, PHYSICS and ENGINEERING related competencies such as Camp Layout and Camp Development, Orienteering and Navigational Skills using compass, Rope Course, Scaling the Heights, Archery, Marksmanship, Exploring Himamaylan, Outdoor Skills, Scoutcrafts, Campcrafts; **EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS** such as Firemanship, Rescue, Lifesaving, First Aid, and Survival Skills; **ENVIRONMENTAL STEWARDSHIP** such as Himamaylan Urban Gardening (HUG), Tree Planting / Tree Parenting, Clean-up Drive; and **LITERACY / NUMERACY** skills through Community Of Readers and Numerates (CORN).

**SPECIAL ACTIVITIES**

- ❖ Big Books, Story Writing, Storytelling, Song Writing, Spoken Poetry Competitions
  - ❖ Theatre, Traditional and Modern Dances, Band, Scout Drill, Painting, Photography Workshops and Competitions
  - ❖ Cooking, Housekeeping, Home Repair, Plumbing, Sculpture and Wood Carving
  - ❖ Solid Waste Management, Recycling and Handicrafts
5. **Registration.** A registration of **Five Hundred Pesos (Php 500.00)** shall be charged each participant to defray expenses for the program materials, administrative costs, souvenirs, and other operating expenses. The registration fee, food, transportation, and other incidental expenses are chargeable to Local Funds / Special Education Fund 2023 / School/Division MOOE, subject to usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.  
**Transportation** and Equipment: Contingent will be responsible for bringing their camp equipment and arranging their own transportation to and from the campsite. Like in any other camping, Scouts and Adult Leaders are required to provide their own camping equipment and gadgets.
  6. All participating City / Municipal and Districts including Public Secondary and Elementary Schools, and Private Schools are requested to prepare for the cultural presentation, which will be presented in the evening at the Grand Arena. Drum and Bugle Corps, which would like to participate in the exhibition may inform the EXECOM early to ensure that they can be included, as one of the participants.



7. Qualifications for Participation:

a. Scout is expected to have leadership potentials, physically fit to undergo strenuous activities and parent's approval, and must be:

- Currently registered as Boy/ Senior Scouts;
- At least 10 years old for Boy Scouts and 13 years old but not over 17 years old for Senior Scouts;
- Equipped with camping gears;
- Duly examined by registered Physician certifying his/her good health condition to attend this event.


b. ADULT LEADER must have maturity and clarity about his role and must be:


- Currently registered Unit Leader;
- Trained Troop Leader/Outfit Advisor and undergone at least BTC for Unit Leaders;
- Duly examined by registered Physician certifying his/her good health condition to attend this event;
- Of good moral character.

8. Additional guidelines for the Advancement Camporee will be issued from time to time by the Camporee EXECOM to enable scouts and scouters within the territory of the Council prepare and keep inform with the development of the Camporee.
