INTERNATIONAL ADOLESCENT HEALTH WEEK 2022

The International Adolescent Health Week is an annual health campaign every third week of March that is observed globally since 2018. It engages adolescents in meaningful activities and urges communities to help teenagers make a smooth transition into adulthood.

In line with this, the Office of the Undersecretary for Administration (OUA), through the Bureau of Learner Support Services-School Health Division (BLSS-SHD), shall conduct a Virtual Celebration of the International Adolescent Health Week 2022 from March 21 to 26, 2022 (Monday to Saturday).

The theme for this year is 'Transitions' which highlights the changes from childhood to adulthood physically and mentally, the adjustments from a prepandemic life into a situation affected by the COVID-19 health crisis, and from lifestyles characterized by dependence as children to independence.
