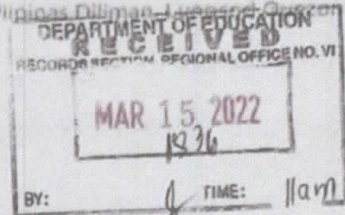

### **KONSEPTONG PAPEL**

Ang UP Lipunang Pangkasaysayan, bilang pinakamatandang organisasyong pangkasaysayan ng Unibersidad ng Pilipinas Diliman, ay mayroong adhikaing magsulong at magtaguyod ng isang kritikal at mas makabuluhang pag-aaral ng kasaysayan. Layunin ng samahan na mapagbuklod ang mga mag-aaral, dalubhasa, at ang mga mamamayang mayroong angking hilig, interes, at pagmamahal sa larangan. Sa bawat pagkakataong magsasagawa ng mga aktibidad, tunguhin ng UP LIKAS na hindi lamang maipamalas at mahasa ang katalinuhan at kahusayan sa disiplina ng mga kalahok kundi para rin mahubog pa lalo ang kamalayang pangkasaysayan ng sambayanang Pilipino. Dulot ng malubhang sitwasyong dala ng pandemya, naantala ang ang organisasyon sa pagsasagawa ng iba't ibang patimpalak. Gayunpaman, muling magbabalik ang palatuntunang kaakibat ng mga ito para sa ikalawang semestre ng kasalukuyang taong panuruan 2021-2022 sa makabagong anyo at pagkakakilanlan.

Sa pagdiriwang ng ika-34 taong anibersaryo ng UP LIKAS, inihahandog ng organisasyon ang *KaKASa Ka Ba? 2022* kung saan magiging kalahok sa programa ang mga mag-aaral mula sa sekondaryang antas at kolehiyo sa Pilipinas. Ang *KaKASa Ka Ba?* ay bubuun ng tatlong bahagi - ang TalasKASaysayan (debate), KASanaysayan (pagsulat ng sanaysay), at KASplay (*Cosplay*). Sa kasalukuyang kalagayan dulot ng pandemya at *remote learning*, pansamantalang isasagawa sa pamamaraang *online* ang mga paligsahan. Ang mga mag-aaral mula sa sekondaryang antas at kolehiyo na magnanais na sumali sa mga nabanggit na aktibidad ay kinakailangan sagutan ang *Google Form* na ilalabas sa *Facebook Page* ng UP LIKAS sa kaukulang panahon ng pagpaparchistro.

# UP LIPUNANG PANGKASAYSAYAN

Ang TalasKASaysayan ay magbubukas ng talakayan at talastasan sa pagitan ng mga estudyante sa kolehiyo ukol sa mga isyung namamayagpag sa kasaysayan na mayroong kaugnayan sa kontemporaryong konteksto. Mayroon itong tatlong yugto: (1) *Elimination round*, na magsasala sa walong grupong makalalahok sa talastasan; (2) *Semi-finals*, kung saan sasabak sa talastasan ang apat na pangkat na makakapasa sa unang bahagi, at (3) *Finals*, upang matukoy kung sino sa dalawang matitirang panig ang maitatanghal na nagwagi. Magiging kabahagi rin sa TalasKasaysayan ang mga huradong mayroong taglay na kaalaman at kasanayan sa pakikipagtalastasan at pag-aaral ng kasaysayan. Samantala, sa KASanaysayan, itatampok ng 15 mag-aaral mula sa sekondarya ang kanilang angking talino sa pagbuo ng isang sanaysay ukol sa isang mapipiling partikular na paksa o tanong na mayroong kinalaman sa konteksto ng nakaraan. Ang kanilang mga isusulat ay mamarkahan ng mga dalubhasa sa disiplina batay sa pamantayang ilalahad ng organisasyon. Pagdating naman sa KASplay, ibibida ng 20 kalahok ang kanilang pagiging malikhain sa pagsusuot ng mga damit na mayroong kabuluhan o kaugnayan sa kasaysayan. Magtatalaga rin ng mga huradong magbibigay grado sa mga iprepresentang larawan ng mga kalahok nang naayon sa wastong pamantayan. "*First come, first serve*" ang magiging basehan sa pagsali sa mga nasabing aktibidad. Ang mga papalaring mananalo para sa mga patimpalak ay makakatanggap ng kaukulang gantimpala mula sa organisasyon.

Sa pamamagitan ng *KaKASa Ka Ba?*, lubos na inaasahan na lalong mag-aalab ang pagmamahal at pagpapahalaga ng mga kalahok na mag-aaral at mamamayan sa pagtuklas ng nakaraan. Hangarin ng samahan na maging tulay ang programa tungo sa pagsulong at pag-angat ng pag-aaral sa larangan. Higit sa lahat, layunin ng UP LIKAS na maging kasangkapan ang aktibidad na ito sa paghubog ng paninindigan, pagtindig sa katotohanan, at panlipunang katwiran ng mga Pilipino gamit ang lente at disiplina ng kasaysayan.
