

**SELECTION GUIDELINES FOR INCOMING GRADE 7 LEARNERS
IN REGIONAL SCIENCE HIGH SCHOOL (RSHS) FOR
REGION VI – SCHOOL YEAR 2023-2024**

To: Schools Division Superintendents
All Others Concerned

1. This Office will conduct the Competitive Admission Tests (CAT) for the Grade 7 Learners of the Regional Science High School for Region VI (RSHS-VI) SY 2023-2024.

Qualification Requirements:

- Certified machine copy of Grade 6 SF-9 (School Report Card);
- Average rating of 85% in Grade 6 English, Science & Mathematics (from First to Third Quarter) and no grade below 80% in all subjects;
- Average Grade of 83% in each of the other subjects (First to Third Quarter);
- A Certification from the school head/principal that the applicant belongs to top 10 or upper 10% of Grade 6 graduating class; and
- Duly accomplished application form with 2 pieces 1 x 1 ID picture.

2. The selection shall be done in three (3) stages to determine the qualifiers.
- Phase 1 – Qualifying Examination
 - Phase 2 – Proficiency Test in Science, English, and Mathematics
 - Phase 3 – Interview of the student with the parent by the RSHS VI Screening Committee. The interview shall be rated in accordance with the prepared rubrics and shall be an integral part of the score obtained by the applicant.

The top 180 qualifiers will be admitted for enrolment provided they meet the final rating requirements.

3. A registration fee of FIFTY PESOS (P 50.00) shall be charged to each applicant duly receipted to defray the expenses for the printing of testing materials, supplies, and meals of examiners and other members of the screening committee during the three (3) stages of the selection process and other related expenses.

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4.5 Posting of Grade 7 Qualifiers : July 3, 2023

5. The application Form can be downloaded at RSHS VI Facebook Bulletin through: www.facebook.com.savans updates. The hard copy of the application form will be available at the RSHS VI Administration Office, Banga, Aklan starting April 26, 2023.
6. The Schools Division Office of Aklan shall announce the final result of the selection process of qualified incoming RSHS VI Grade 7 learners duly verified and validated by the Regional Office.
7. Teaching and non-teaching staff who will render services during the test material preparation, interview, checking, and releasing of results will be given service credits/compensatory leave credits for services rendered on Saturdays, Sundays, and Holidays. It is understood, however, that these service credits shall be used only to offset absences and not for the commutation of leave credits for purpose of monetization. Compensatory time off is non-cumulative and should be utilized within one year. This is granted pursuant to CSC and DBM Joint Circular No. 2, s. 2004, dated October 2004.
