AWARDING OF MEDALS AND TROPHIES TO THE 2023 CITY MEET WINNING LEARNER-ATHLETES DURING THE SY 2022-2023 SCHOOL RECOGNITION PROGRAM

- 1. DepEd Order No. 36, s. 2016 or the Policy Guidelines on Awards and Recognition for the K To 12 Basic Education Program articulates that recognition be given to learners who have shown exemplary performance in specific areas of their school life. It recognizes that all students have their unique strengths that need to be identified, strengthened, and publicly acknowledged. Furthermore, in support of the holistic development of Filipino learners, this policy highlights to veer away from valuing only academic achievement based on high grades and move toward valuing and celebrating a wide range of student achievements.

In light of this, this Office is directing the public elementary and secondary schools with winning learner-athletes during the 2023 City Sports and Athletic Meet to award medals and trophies during the SY 2022-2023 School Recognition Day Program in order to promote sense of pride, motivation, and inspiration.
- 3. In carrying out this activity in the schools under this Division, the Public Schools District Supervisors and School Heads are expected to adhere to the provisions of DepEd Order No. 36, s. 2016, which provides guidance to both public and private elementary and secondary schools nationwide in the Policy Guidelines on Awards and Recognition for the K To 12 Basic Education.
- 4. Beginning June 13, 2023, all District Sports Coordinators are directed to claim the medals and trophies from the Supply Office. Please present the List of Winning Learner-Athletes (1st, 2nd, & 3rd placers) duly signed by the Public Schools District Supervisors when claiming the medals and trophies.
