

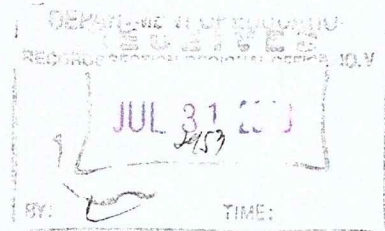

- SDG No. 8 Decent Work and Economic Growth



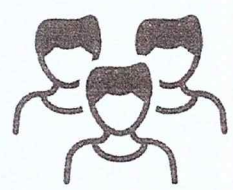


## Global Youth Summit: A Multi-sector Partnership
