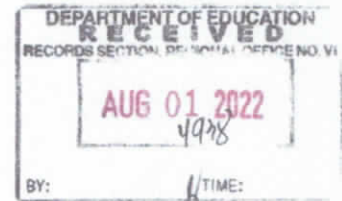

The United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization (UNESCO) is leading the global efforts together with its partners and stakeholders to promote transformative education to tackle the planetary crisis, through the new global framework for the period 2020-2030, entitled "Education for Sustainable Development: Towards Achieving the Sustainable Development Goals," with its main goal of ensuring all learners acquire knowledge, skills, values, and attitudes to tackle climate change.

With the objective to ensure climate action is integrated into the curriculum globally, UNESCO is developing *green curriculum* guidelines to help integrate climate education in schools. These guidelines are to be co-developed with young people from 12 to 25 years old. Said guidelines shall reflect the needs and demands of youth on climate change education.
