2022 DIVISION FESTIVAL OF TALENTS: NEW NORMAL EDITION

1. This Schools Division of Kabankalan City through the Curriculum Implementation Division (CID) will conduct the **2022 Division Festival of Talents: New Normal Edition** with the theme, "**Empowering the K to 12 Learners Through Authentic Performances in the New Normal**" on November 21 – 24, 2022.
2. The 2022 DFOT generally aims to showcase performances across disciplines of K to 12 learners in the new normal. Specifically, this activity has the following objectives:
 - a. provide an authentic avenue for learners to showcase their learnings beyond the classrooms through varied performances in Kindergarten, English, Filipino, Math, Science, Araling Panlipunan, MSEP/MAPEH, TLE/EPP, Edukasyon sa Pagpapakatao, Alternative Learning System, Indigenous Peoples, and Special Education;
 - b. serve as a platform for assessing learners' artistic abilities, language, scientific, technological and livelihood skills, critical analysis for deep reasoning, among other abilities which are set in the K to 12 Basic Education Curriculum;
 - c. improve learners' confidence and self-esteem while instilling in them the value of camaraderie, integrity, honesty, and sportsmanship; and
 - d. make the learners find meaning out of their experiences across disciplines and categories of the competition.
3. The 2022 DFOT will be conducted through hybrid modality by repackaging the different events in this festival to make it more responsive and relevant to the new normal set up.
4. The participants to this activity are the Program Management Team (PMT), Officers of the Master Teachers Association of Kabankalan City, Select Teachers of the eight learning areas, vaccinated learners, and the Technical Working Group (TWG).
5. Strict observance of the minimum health and safety protocols shall be practiced all throughout the activity. This is also to ensure the strict compliance of health and safety protocols set by Inter-Agency Task Force (IATF).

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GENERAL GUIDELINES FOR THE 2022 DIVISION FESTIVAL OF TALENTS

1. The theme for this year's Division Festival of Talents: New Normal Edition is, "Empowering the K to 12 Learners Through Authentic Performances in the New Normal" via hybrid modality.
2. The 2022 DFOT: New Normal Edition will showcase the talents and skills of learners in all or any of the following areas:

3. Learners, teacher-coaches, judges, and facilitators who will participate in the showcase of talents and skills will receive a certificate of participation and recognition from the Division through the Curriculum Implementation Division.
4. All five districts are expected to participate. Each district is given the option to decide on which events they can participate in. There shall be one (1) entry for each event.





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5. The feedback from the experts shall be given after all the presentations in each event for learners and teachers to gain insights for further improvement.
6. The district presentations must adhere to the existing Inter-Agency Task Force (IATF) for the Management of Emerging Infectious Diseases Protocols; child protection and other related policies. Consent must be sought from the parents or guardians of the learner/ participants for the airing of the 2022 DFOT on FB live. Each event venue will have an assigned Media Team to ensure full coverage of the program while a news anchor will be assigned at the Media Center, SDO Green Room.
7. The Program Handlers (EPSs, IPed, and ALS) shall take charge of the Guidelines, Rules, Mechanics, and Criteria of the contests to be shared with the Public Schools District Supervisors and School Heads for dissemination in the field on or before October 3, 2022.
8. Each Program Handler shall create their own team (committees) to handle the competition, and shall also identify their respective venues.
