ADOPTION OF THE CONTEXTUALIZED 8 - WEEK CURRICULA FOR KEY STAGE 1

TO: Asst. Schools Division Superintendent Chiefs, CID and SGOD Public Schools District Supervisors Public Elementary School Heads All Others Concerned

- 1. In support of the MATATAG Agenda of the Department of Education, this Office is bent on addressing the low level of literacy and numeracy among K to 12 learners. This will be attained by providing directions through the Division Literacy and Numeracy Roadmap (DLNR) that are aligned with the Region's Literacy and Numeracy Excellence (LiNE) and DepEd's road map for the next six years focusing on the foundational skills in Key Stage 1 curriculum.
- 2.
