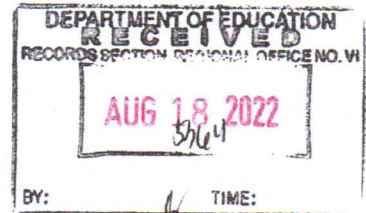

Greetings!

The Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD), one of the leading organizations advocating for the protection and rights of children, continues to promote legal adoption as the only procedure that guarantees that every Filipino child—whether abandoned, neglected, orphaned, or surrendered—will receive the proper care.


The Simulated Birth Rectification Act, also known as Republic Act 11222, is one of the adoption laws in the country. It is an administrative adoption procedure that exempts individuals from administrative, civil, and criminal liabilities, grants amnesty and permits the correction of the child's birth record, and additionally offers a straightforward and less expensive adoption process. The law has a ten-year window of implementation and shall commence by March 29, 2029. The Department has already started promoting the law through radio advertorials, social media postings, and distribution of IEC materials to all the municipalities in Western Visayas, and it is still looking for platforms to do so with the remaining seven (7) years of implementation.

Anent thereto, we kindly request your assistance in spreading awareness of the aforementioned law by exhibiting our audio-visual presentation to TV screens and/or posting our poster or any means your office may allow.
