2023 INTERNATIONAL COASTAL CLEAN-UP

- Presidential Proclamation No. 470 Series of 2003, declared the Third (3rd) Saturday of September of each year as the "International Coastal Clean-Up Day". This year's International Coastal Clean-Up will be celebrated on the third Saturday of this month - September 16, 2023.
- International Coastal Cleanup aims to engage people around the world to remove trash and debris from beaches, waterways and other water bodies, to identify the sources of the litter, to change behaviors that causes pollution and to raise awareness on the extent of the marine debris problem.
