




Subject: 68th ANNUAL COUNCIL MEETING

1. The Boy Scouts of the Philippines - Negros Occidental Council will conduct its 68th Annual Council Meeting on September 20, 2022 at **EVACUATION CENTER, SITIO BAJAY, BRGY. 3, HIMAMAYLAN CITY**, upon cordial acceptance of Mayor Rogelio Raymund I. Tongson newly elected Chairman of Himamaylan City Scouting Committee with the Theme "Sustaining Growth".
2. Pursuant to the Republic Act. No. 11469, an Act Declaring the Existence of a National Emergency Arising from the COVID-19 Situation, all physical attendees should at least have received vaccinations and observe proper health protocols.
3. The holding of the Annual Council Meeting purposely to evaluate the implementation of Council Operation based on the Calendar of Activities and Events last Scouting year just ended, receiving reports, conducting elections of the regular members of the Local Council Executive Board, passing upon the application for renewal charter and transacting such other business as may be properly come before such meeting. Annual Reports of the Council Chairman and Treasurer will be presented for approval of the delegates.
4. Per Local Council by-laws, official delegates who can vote the nominated candidates for the Regular Members of the LCEB are the following.
 - Members of the Council Executive Board and Council Commissioners Staff;
 - City/municipal/District Chairmen and Vice Chairmen;
 - City/municipal/District Scout Commissioners and its Deputies including Field Commissioners;
 - Institutional Heads /Coordinators, Lay Leaders and Members-at-Large.
 - Credentials – participants must be prepared (if required) to present their current membership cards when they register for the conference, those who have not renewed their membership registration onsite re-registration will be available.
5. No voting by proxy of the candidates for the Regular Members of the LCEB. Nomination forms must be submitted on or before 13th of September 2022 to the Council Nomination and Election Committee chaired by SDS MARSETTE D. SABBALUCA, CESO VI, Council Scout Commissioner for proper action thru the Council Office on the given deadline.

6. To defray the cost of Administration such as certificates and awards for the delegates and other documentary paper works such as Council Chairman's Report and Treasurer's Report, proceedings of the Council Meeting and Programs, a minimal registration fee of Php 250.00 (Two Hundred Fifty Pesos Only) will be charged each delegates chargeable to Local Funds subject to usual according procedures in accordance to Law.
7. **Conference Fee** must be paid directly to the BSP NOC via GCash for those attending online, whereas, those attending onsite may do it upon registration on the venue.
8. Conference fee, travel expenses of the delegates to the 68th ACM may be charged against Local Fund/MOOE subject to usual accounting and auditing procedures set by law.
9. Full support of all City/Municipal/District Scouting Committees is earnestly desired. Thus, may we request the different City Schools Division Superintendents in the Province of Negros Occidental to support this annual activity of KEY Leaders in Scouting in our Council to ensure maximum attendance during the affair.
