- 2. The said activity will showcase the innovative implementation of basic education services in the six categories, namely: Curriculum and Instruction Delivery; Policy, Planning, Research, and Governance; Learning Environment Improvement; Human Resource Development; ALS, SPED, & IPEd Programs; and Farm Schools (for farm school implementers only).
- 3. This educational innovation showdown is open to all permanent school and SDO personnel who had implemented an innovation under the different innovation categories from SY 2022-2023 / FY 2022 that was not previously presented in any governance level showdown. The innovation paper of the participating innovator/s has been duly signed by the PSDS/Chief Education Supervisor/Administrative Officer V.
- 4. Each district shall be represented by their respective top scorers in the following classifications of innovators, if available, during the Division Innovation Showdown:
 - a. Teaching
 - b. Related Teaching
 - c. Non-Teaching
- 5. SDO-based Related Teaching and Non-Teaching Personnel may submit the requirements on or before November 23, 2023 and shall present on November 24, 2023 at the New Conference Hall, SDO Kabankalan City. The top scorers among Related Teaching

and Non-Teaching innovators shall represent the SDO proper during the Division Innovation Showdown in two classifications.

- 6. The top scorers of the Districts in each classification, as assisted by the District Innovation Focal Person, shall submit:
 - a. duly signed innovation paper,
 - b. 5-minute recorded oral presentation, and
 - c. 5-minute comprehensive video clip properly endorsed by the District Evaluation Committee to the Planning and Research Unit (PRU) on November 24, 2023 thru the Google Drive link http://bit.ly/2023WinningInnov. The recorded presentations will be played during the Division Innovation Showdown followed by a 5-minute open forum with the Division Evaluation Committee.
- 7. Moreover, a special award on the Most Sustained Innovation will also be given during the Division Innovation Showdown. The awarded District Innovators of the previous year (2022) shall submit the following:
 - a. a comprehensive 5-minute video clip on how they sustained their innovation, and
 - b. duly signed implementation plan on or before November 24, 2023 thru the given Google Drive.
- 8. Only one (1) winner per classification shall be selected at the division level regardless of categories. The innovator/s shall be awarded as Division Innovator/s of the Year. The winners in the division level shall automatically represent the Schools Division of Kabankalan City to the Regional Innovation Showdown.
- 9. It is understood that in the conduct of this activity, there shall be no discrimination on account of age, gender, civil status, disability, religion, ethnicity, political affiliation, or any other similar factor or circumstance that runs counter to the principles of equal opportunity.
