**PEOPLE LIVE WHEN PEOPLE GIVE: A BLOOD LETTING ACTIVITY AND OTHER
MEDICAL AND NURSING SERVICES OF SDO- KABANKALAN CITY**

1. Pursuant to **Republic Act No. 7719 otherwise known as the "National Blood Services Act of 1994"** and **Oplan Kalusugan sa Department of Education**, this Office through the Health and Nutrition Unit participates in the campaign of the government in ensuring an adequate supply of human blood through voluntary blood donation and collaborates with the **Negros First Provincial Blood Center** of the Province of Negros Occidental for a **bloodletting activity on November 8, 2022, 9:00 a.m. at the Division Conference Hall.**
2. The objectives of this activity are the following:
 - a. promote and encourage voluntary blood donation by the citizenry and to instill public consciousness of the principle that the blood donation is a humanitarian act;
 - b. help the government provide adequate, safe, affordable, and equitable distribution of supply of blood and blood products;
 - c. inform the public/personnel of the need for voluntary blood donation to curb the hazards caused by the commercial sale of blood;
 - d. inform the public/personnel of the benefits and rationale of blood donation; and
 - e. encourage active participation and mobilization of other sectors of the community in the mechanisms of voluntary blood donation.
3. The following are the parameters to be observed by donors prior to blood donation:
 - a. Must weigh at least 50 kgs;
 - b. Must be in good health and feeling well;



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- c. Eat a healthy meal, avoid fatty food and get plenty of sleep the night before the blood donation;
 - d. No congenital coagulation factor deficiency;
 - e. No liquor consumption 24 hours prior to blood donation;
 - f. No medication intake for at least 24 hours prior to donating blood; and
 - g. The interval between two donations should be 3 months or more;
4. Public Schools District Supervisors of each district are hereby enjoined to send at least ten (10) possible donors. The names shall be submitted to Health and Nutrition Unit on or before November 7, 2022.
5. The following School Coordinators are encouraged to participate as donors:
- a. DRRM School Coordinators
 - b. OK sa DepEd School Coordinators
 - c. Boy Scout/Girl Scout School Coordinators
 - d. Youth Formation Coordinators
6. This Memorandum shall serve as travel order for teaching and non-teaching personnel who will serve as blood donors.
7. Travel and other incidental expenses incurred by the school personnel participating in this activity shall be charged against School MOOE, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
