This is in reference to the attached letter of Undersecretary and Chief of Staff Epimaco V. Densing III, this Department, addressed to Hon. Erwin T. Tulfo, Secretary, Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD), dated October 20, 2022. The said letter informs the DSWD Secretary that the Department of Education shall no longer allow its teachers to facilitate the monitoring and generation of reports for the 4Ps in their respective schools, pursuant to DepEd's objective of lessening the non-teaching workload of the teachers.

In view of the foregoing, all Regional Directors are instructed to coordinate with their respective counterparts at the DSWD and local government units to facilitate the immediate transition and turnover of the aforementioned tasks to the DSWD.



As such, we intend to advise at the soonest possible time our teachers to turn over these tasks to your personnel.

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This pertains to our recent communication with the Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD) with regard to this Department's position to lessen the non-teaching workload of our teachers. As such, we shall no longer allow our teachers to monitor 4Ps attendance in our public schools.
