

1. Deadline for registration: December 18, 2022 (Google Forms closes at 24:00 am)
2. Deadline for submissions: January 16, 2023 (postmark as proof)
3. The envelope should be indicated "2022 Fourteenth International Fo Guang Yuan Young Artist Award"
4. Selection date and location: 29 January 2023, at Mabuhay Temple, Manila
5. Final date and location: April 2023 in Kaohsiung, Taiwan
6. The results will be announced to all schools by letter in May 2023

IV. Entry Rules

1. Entries must conform to the theme specified by the Organizer.
2. The size of the drawing paper is 54cm x 39cm, which cannot be smaller than A3 paper. May request drawing paper from the co-organizer or provide own material. (No framing is required)
3. A4 paper size Microsoft Word application form designated by the organizer must be pasted on the back of the work and filled in with complete information and legible.
4. Entries must be original works, and works that have participated in other competitions or have been published are not accepted. Works should not be posed under a false name, drawn by others, refined by others, or copying, imitation, plagiarism, etc. according to ready-made pictures.
5. Only the original paintings will be accepted. Photocopied, printed or digital works will not be accepted.
6. There is no set limitation to the use of painting utensils and media. Each person is limited to one entry.

V. Participants and Divisions

Open to students aged 5 to 15 years

1. Kindergarten (ages 5 and above)
2. Grade 1-2
3. Grade 3-4
4. Grade 5-7
5. Grade 8-10

VI. Prizes

1. Individual Prizes:

- (1) **Buddha's Light Award:** NT\$8,000, a certificate and prize (totals 5 divisions/1 winner per division)
 - (2) **Distinction Award:** NT\$6,000, a certificate and prize (totals 5 divisions/1 winner per division)
 - (3) **Outstanding Award:** NT\$3,000, a certificate and prize (totals 5 divisions/1 winner per division)
 - (4) **Excellence Award:** NT\$1,000, a certificate and prize (totals 5 divisions/20 winner per division)
 - (5) **Honorable Mention:** A certificate and prize (depending on the number of entries)
- ### 2. Group Prizes:
2. **Group Prizes:** Certificates (for three groups with the most winners)
 3. Winning artworks will be selected for international touring exhibitions.

VII. Special Announcement

1. **Entry method :** Participants may apply individually and paint at home, or be enrolled collectively by schools or other organizations to paint in their group entities.
2. **Entries :** Entries will not be returned. The copyrights belong to the organizer, "Fo Guang Shan Cultural and Educational Foundation"
3. **Award tax :** According to the R.O.C. tax law, the organizer is required to withhold the tax.

4. 参赛作品必须是原创作品，不接受参加过其他比赛或已公开发表的作品，不得有冒名顶替、他人代画、他人加笔或依现成图画临摹、模仿、抄袭等。
5. 只接受参赛绘画作品原件，不接受绘画作品复印件、打印件以及电子作品。
6. 画作风格及媒材不拘，每人限一件参加。
