- 1. Pursuant to Regional Memorandum No. 146, s 2021**, anchored on the Regional Mantra which highlights that ALS Learners are champions, the Schools Division of Kabankalan City will join the **Simultaneous Regional Launching of the Skills Package for Alternative Learning System (ALS) Learners on May 21, 2021 from 9:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m.** via Facebook Live.

**MECHANICS IN THE CONDUCT OF THE REGIONWIDE LAUNCHING  
OF "PAINTING KO, BUHAY KO"**

1. The number of participants during the launching in the school division is subject to the approval of the Inter-Agency Task Force on COVID-19.
2. The venue for the conduct of the launching is preferably an open space which will allow participants to observe health and safety protocols and must have a stable internet connection.
3. The participants must be required to wear face masks and face shield throughout the duration of the activity. The technical working group must ensure that social distancing is strictly observed.
4. A minimum of twenty-five (25) ALS Learners, who are program beneficiaries, per SDO are encouraged to participate during the launching.
5. The Division ALS Focal Person is tasked to lead the conduct of the launching in the school division.
6. There will be one-hour painting session during the launching of "Painting Ko, Buhay Ko."
7. The Senior Education Program Specialist for Social Mobilization and Networking, in coordination with the Mobile Teachers and District ALS Coordinators, shall engage partners in the conduct of the virtual launching especially in the provision of trainer-artist and needed materials.
8. The Division Information Technology Officer shall coordinate with the Regional Information Technology Officer in the conduct of the regionwide launching.
9. The partners and stakeholders are encouraged to take part during the launching of "Painting Ko, Buhay Ko."



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
