A. Spoken Word Poetry Guidelines and Criteria (Elementary)

Spoken Word Poetry is a performance art that is word based. It is a writing that is meant to be spoken or delivered with emotions recorded in a video. It is an oral art that focuses on the art of word play, rhythm, improvisation, intonation and voice inflection.

- The contest is open to all elementary learners of Schools Division Office of Kabankalan.
- Poetry piece must be an original composition. It could be written in Hiligaynon, Filipino or English, but not in tagasih.
- The piece must be related to the theme and must not contain any malicious and offensive content.
- Each participant is given 2-3 minutes to recite or deliver his/her piece in a video.
- Sounds, instrumental or music background is allowed to complement the delivery. No deduction shall be made if the contestant opts not to have a musical background.
- Name of participant and school shall not be mentioned in the performance and should not be visible in the video.
- Video and copy of piece shall be submitted through dexyllgarl.dejesus@deped.gov.ph on or before October 26, 2021.
- Entries will be subject for judging. Panel of Judges shall compose of knowledgeable personnel from the different functional units in the Division Office.
- Decision of the judges is final and irrevocable.

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B. Trash to Treasure Vlog Guidelines and Criteria (Secondary)

Showcase of creativity and resourcefulness by exploring the 3Rs of waste management - Reduce, Reuse, Recycle. The main principles of this activity are to re-envision our relationship with nature, and put forward new ways to co-exist with the environment, to create art which informs the viewer of environmental issues, nature, and its processes, and to creatively propose new ways for sustainability, healing, and coexistence.

- The contest is open to all secondary learners of Schools Division Office of Kabankalan.
- Entry must be related to the theme and must not contain any malicious and offensive content.
- Materials to be used could be anything that are second hand items that otherwise would be thrown away, or any natural materials found around your home (fallen leaves, flowers, etc.)
- Ready or semi-finished model or material is not allowed.
- Process and explanation of the project shall be recorded in a 5-minute video. (Not necessarily the entire process. Content shall be depending upon the participant on how he/she wants to showcase his/her project) Explanation can be in Hiligaynon, Filipino, English or combination of both.
- Entries will be judged on creativity, utilization of resources, artistic composition and design, stability, durability and sustainability of finished product, its usefulness and functionality, and overall presentation.
- Video and list of materials used shall be submitted through dexyllgarl.dejesus@deped.gov.ph on or before October 26, 2021.
- Entries will be subject for judging. Panel of Judges shall compose of knowledgeable personnel from the different functional units in the Division Office.
- Decision of the judges is final and irrevocable.
