IMPLEMENTATION OF SCHOOL-BASED FEEDING PROGRAM – NUTRITIOUS FOOD PRODUCTS SY 2021-2022

1. The Department of Education (DepEd), through the Bureau of Learner Support Services-School Health Division (BLSS-SHD), maintains its commitment to provide good nutrition to learners amidst the COVID-19 pandemic. As such, it shall continue the implementation of the **School-Based Feeding Program (SBFP) for School Year (SY) 2021-2022** to address hunger and encourage learners to enroll, contribute to the improvement of their nutritional status, provide nourishment for their growth and development and help boost their immune system, and enhance and improve their health and nutrition values.

2. In consideration of the changes brought about by the pandemic as to how learning will be delivered for SY 2021-2022, the implementation of the SBFP shall be modified, putting utmost importance to the welfare, safety, and health of learners and personnel involved, while also ensuring the attainment of the program objectives. The SBFP shall be implemented in line with the Basic Education Learning Continuity Plan (BE-LCP) and in strict compliance with the DepEd's required health standards.

3. The SBFP's primary beneficiaries for SY 2021-2022 shall be all incoming kindergarten learners enrolled as of July 15, 2021, and the Grade 1 to Grade 6 learners who were wasted and severely wasted based on the SY 2020-2021 SBFP report, except those who have moved to Grade 7.

4. The program shall provide beneficiaries with nutritious food products—through rationing—for at least 60 feeding days.

5. Identified drop-off schools shall be the same with 2020 SBFP Nutritious Food Products Implementation.


6. There will be a once a week delivery, every Thursday starting November 11, 2021.

7. Faculty member or authorized school representative assigned to pick up food packs are requested to be at the Drop-Off Location at 8:00AM-10:00AM.

8. An authorization letter is needed if the person is not the SBFP Coordinator. All allotted food products for each school shall be picked up before noon of the scheduled date. Drop Off schools shall not be held liable for any loss of the unclaimed food items.



9. Attached is the approved cycle menu (Enclosure 1) for the implementation. Schools shall instruct parents to encourage beneficiaries to consume breads first to avoid spoilage. No parent's consent is required for the consumption of food products.
10. Schools must select the most appropriate distribution scheme that will guarantee the freshness of food products. Parent's signatures should be secured using the Distribution List Form. (Enclosure No. 2). Inspection and Acceptance Report Form –Appendix 62 should be filled-out every delivery (Enclosure No.3).
11. School-based feeding implementers are requested to check the Official SBFP Kabankalan Division Facebook Page daily for updates and announcement.
12. Transportation Expenses to cover travel, hauling and other school expenses in the implementation of the program shall be downloaded to schools.
13. School heads are enjoined to extend full administrative support, CID and SGOD personnel shall monitor the implementation of the SBFP-Nutritious Food Products.
14. All other provisions in the existing guidelines on the implementation of the SBFP-Milk Feeding Component as stated in DO 031, S. 2021 shall remain in force, unless sooner repealed, amended, or rescinded.
