

Guidelines and Mechanics

**OBJECTIVES**

The contest aims to;

1. provide an opportunity for the learners to showcase their talents and skills;
2. engage learners in advocating and the promotion of their rights and responsibilities; and
3. deepen the learners' knowledge on their rights and responsibilities.

**GUIDELINES**

1. The contest is open to all currently enrolled learners from both public and private elementary and secondary schools in the Schools Division Office of Kabankalan City.
2. Schools may submit several entries but there is only one entry per learner.
3. The content of the poetry must be based on the 2021 National Children's Month theme "New Normal na Walang Iwanan: Karapatan ng Bawat Bata Ating Tutukan".
4. The poetry must be written and spoken in either English or Tagalog. Taglish is not allowed.
5. A written copy and video recording of spoken poetry performance must be submitted to [gerald.tampico@deped.gov.ph](mailto:gerald.tampico@deped.gov.ph) on or before 5:00 PM of November 19, 2021.

1. Entries submitted will be judged on the following criteria:

Originality	-	10%
