**MASS VACCINATION AGAINST COVID-19 FOR THE TEACHING AND
NON-TEACHING PERSONNEL OF DEP-ED SDO KABANKALAN CITY**

1. Pursuant to **DepEd Memorandum No. 28, s. 2021** titled, "**Comprehensive Guidance on the Participation of the Department of Education in the Implementation of the Philippine National Deployment and Vaccination Plan (NDVP) for COVID-19 Vaccines**", this Office shares its responsibility in ensuring the health, safety, and well-being of learners and personnel while delivering its mandate. Along with the strict adherence to the minimum public health and safety standards, vaccines were developed to effectively protect the community in minimizing the transmission, preventing the severity of the symptoms, and reducing possibility of severe cases leading to deaths. Thus, per information from the Office of the City Mayor, there will be a **Mass Vaccination against COVID-19** for the teaching and non-teaching personnel of DepEd SDO Kabankalan City on **November 13, 2021 (Saturday), 1:30 pm** at the **KCC gym, Kabankalan City**.
2. The target participants are personnel willing to be vaccinated as reported by their respective school heads. However, the vaccination remains to be personal and voluntary.
3. Teachers and personnel shall bring their valid ID, ballpen and alcohol in the vaccination site.
4. In the interest of public health and safety, all teaching and non-teaching DepEd personnel is reminded to strictly comply to the existing IATF protocols and minimum public health standards.
5. School heads shall ensure attendance of their respective personnel and shall submit their vaccination details to the Health and Nutrition Section through **VIDA GRACE R. MOREÑO, RN**.
6. The Public Schools District Supervisors and the Health and Nutrition Section Vaccination focals are requested to be onsite during the activity to provide the necessary support.
7. The expenses relative to the conduct of the activity shall be charged to the Division MOOE subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
8. Immediate dissemination of and compliance with this Memorandum is desired.
