 In consonance with DepEd's Every Child A Reader Program [ECARP], the SDO of Kabankalan City will conduct a 1-Day Orientation-Workshop on the Administration of the Revised Philippine Informal Reading Inventory [PHIL-IRI] for SY 2018-2019 for GRADE 7 FILIPINO AND ENGLISH TEACHERS on Tuesday, July 17, 2018 at 8:00 in the morning at the Division Conference Hall, Kabankalan City.

- 2. This activity generally aims to orient Grade 7 Filipino and English teachers on the administration of the Revised PHIL-IRI based on the guidelines stipulated in DepEd Order No. 14, s. 2018 as an assessment tool in determining their students' reading levels for appropriate reading interventions. Specifically, this orientation-workshop will provide the participants with:
 - a. knowledge on the administration of the Phil-IRI as a classroom-based assessment tool to measure and describe the learners' reading performance in both Filipino and English languages; and
 - Guidance on the utilization of the assessment results from oral reading, silent reading and listening comprehension
- 3. The participants to this orientation-workshop will come from secondary schools both from the main and extension schools with grade 7 classes:
 - a. One [1] School English Coordinator
 - b. One [1] School Filipino Coordinator
- 4. There will be **NO meals** provided to the participants during the orientation-workshop thus the participants are advised to provide for their snacks and lunch.
- 5. Participants shall bring blank CDs for the Phil-IRI materials.
- Food, transportation and incidental expenses incurred by the participants are chargeable against School MOOE/ local funds and other sources of funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
- 7. Wide dissemination of this memorandum is highly desired.
