2018 DepEd Day Celebration

1. Schools Division Office of Kabankalan City will celebrate **DepEd Day** and at the same time, will host the Opening Salvo of the Kabankalan City **21st Charter Anniversary on July 28, 2018** at the Kabankalan City Public Plaza with the theme “Peace and Progress for Everyone @ 21.
2. There will be series of activities lined up for both public and private teaching and non-teaching personnel of SDO-Kabankalan City to celebrate its 20 years of existence as one of the schools division offices in the region.
3. A Thanksgiving Mass will be held at St. Francis Xavier Cathedral at 6:00 AM followed by the grand parade on the designated route along the major thoroughfares of the city. This will be followed by the Ribbon Cutting for the Opening of the City Agro-Industrial Fair / Exhibit and an Opening Program and Declaration of the Opening of the weeklong celebration of the 21st Charter Anniversary. CONTEST MECHANICS

GUIDELINES OF FLOAT PARADE:

1. Each District will provide a float which will depict any of the DepEd Thrusts/ Best Practices.
2. Floats shall not exceed 30 feet in length including the vehicle.
3. Signage/Tarpaulins must be professionally or neatly printed and proportional to the vehicle.
4. Criteria:
 - Originality and creativity 25%
 - Workmanship (detail of entry design with effectiveness use of colors/materials:..... 20%
 - Relevance to the Deped Thrust25%
 - Overall appearance (neatness, detail, beauty)..... 30%

GUIDELINES FOR THE BEST IN COSTUME CONTEST (Super Heroes)

1. The Contest is open to all teaching and non-teaching personnel of SDO Kabankalan City, both public and private.
2. Participants may choose either local or foreign super heroes.
3. Winners (1 male and 1 female) will be chosen according to the following criteria:
 - Creativity and Innovations..... 30%
 - Appearance and Style..... 30%
 - Costume Factor..... 25%
 - Overall impact..... 15%

4. Winners will be awarded during the Teachers Got Talent.

GUIDELINES FOR THE BEST IN TALENT

1. Each District will have two contestants for the Teacher Got Talent
2. Contestants from public schools must have a permanent status either teaching or non-teaching .
3. There shall be one contestant for every participating private school.
4. Contestants may perform only once during the show. Any participant who will have two or more performances will be disqualified.
5. Contestants shall have a Minimum of 5 minutes and maximum of 7 minutes' performance including the entrance and exit. Every minute excess to the allotted time will be deducted from the total score.
6. Contestants should observe modest attire and should avoid pyrotechnics
7. Contestants shall inform the Chairman of the Committee 3 days before the show of his/her contest piece
8. In group presentation, contestants shall have a Minimum of 5 and maximum of 15 members
9. The Criteria for judging:
 - Presentation30%
 - Mastery.....20%
 - Difficulty of talent.....20%
 - Originality.....10%
 - Stage Presence.....10%
 - Costume.....10%
