## SEMINAR-WORKSHOP ON ENHANCING SKILLS IN ASSESSMENT USING THE REVISED BLOOM'S TAXONOMY ON THE CONDUCT OF PERFORMANCE TASKS

To: Personnel, Curriculum Implementation Division Heads, Public Elementary and Secondary Schools All Others Concerned

- One of the guidelines set in DepEd Order No. 8, s. 2015,"Policy Guidelines on Classroom Assessment for the K to 12 Basic Education Program " states that for Grades 1 to 10, Performance Tasks in Languages, Araling Panlipunan and Edukasyon sa Pagpapakatao has a weight of 50%; Science and Math, 40%; and in MAPEH and TLE/EPP, 60% (Table 4, page 9).
- In line with this guideline, the Schools Division of Kabankalan City shall conduct a Seminar-Workshop on Enhancing Skills in Assessment using the Revised Bloom's Taxonomy on the Conduct of Performance Tasks on September 19-20, 2019 at Zaycoland Resort and Hotel, Kabankalan City.
- 3. This seminar workshop aims to 1) update teachers in Edukasyon sa Pagpapakatao with the current trends in assessment especially in the conduct of performance tests; 2) Capacitate participants with appropriate knowledge, skills, and attitudes in the conduct of performance tests; and 3) enhance capabilities of participants in determining learners' ratings based on the results of both the summative tests in paper –and-pencil and performance tests.
- 4. Participants to this seminar-workshop are all the **School EsP Coordinators** in both elementary and secondary schools and the **personnel from the Curriculum Implementation Division**.
- Travel expenses of the School EsP coordinators relative to their attendance to this activity shall be charged
  to their respective school MOOE while meals and snacks of all the participants shall be charged to the 2019
  HRTD Funds of the Schools Division Office of Kabankalan City subject to usual auditing and accounting
  rules and regulations.
- 6. Participants are advised to bring their Curriculum Guide in EsP and a sample of their performance test conducted in the previous years.
