2018 GLOBAL HANDWASHING DAY CELEBRATION

- Pursuant to the United Nation's (UN) declaration of a Global Handwashing Day (every October 15th) and Philippine House of Representatives Resolution No. 1436 otherwise known as the "Implementation of Annual Global Handwashing Day", the Schools Division Office of Kabankalan City joins in the Celebration of 2018 Global Handwashing Day (GHD) on October 15, 2018.
- 2. Global Handwashing Day is geared towards increasing awareness, and understanding about the importance of handwashing with soap and water as an easy, effective, universal precaution against the spread of opportunistic and pathogenic microorganisms and affordable way to prevent disease. This year's theme, "Clean Hands a recipe for Health", focuses on the links between handwashing and food including food hygiene and nutrition which highlights its significance as part of every meal and keeping food safe, thus prevents sickness among our learners and helps them grow strong.
- 3. All schools are hereby enjoined to participate in a Ten (10) minute Synchronized Handwashing Activity starting at exactly 9:30 in the morning of October 15, 2018.

- 4. The following activities are suggested for the conduct of the above-mentioned celebration:
 - a. Symposium;
 - b. Poster making contest;
 - c. Slogan making contest; and
 - d. Hoisting of streamer/tarpaulin which depicts this year's theme "Clean Hands- a recipe for Health" to strategic areas.
- 4. The celebration is likewise an opportunity to showcase your design, test, and replicate creative ways to encourage people on proper technique of handwashing. Schools are also encouraged to innovate activities to make the celebration more meaningful to learners, teachers, parents and the community. Schools may improvise Handwashing facilities like, tippy top, pvc pipe, bamboo, etc. just to ensure participation to this activity. The Global Handwashing Day Celebration shall be supervised by WASH Club Officers.
- 5. Recognition of Best Implementers shall be based on the following criteria:

a. Most numbered participation by stakeholders
b. Most Innovative way of celebrating the activity
