SUBJECT: REGIONAL JUNIOR/SENIOR AND CADET CAMP

1. Relative to the Negros Occidental; Girl Scout Council Circular No. 26. S 2018, there will be a Regional Camp for Junior, Senior and Cadet on October 24 – 28, 2018 at MYVRPTC, Brgy. Kalunasan, Cebu City with the theme: **Girl Scouts Explore, Endure, Excel**”.
2. Girls Scouts who are registered and have attended the Provincial, Division, District or School Camp are encouraged to participate and Senior Girl Scouts who are applying for the Chief Medal Scheme.
 - a. One Adult Leader per patrol (8 to 10 girls as chaperone for the juniors)
 - b. One adult leader per council for Senior
3. Registration Fee is Php 6,000.00 which will cover the Chartered Ceres Fare, Barge Fee, Terminal Fees, Food, Program materials, souvenir, T-shirt and tours)
