GUIDELINES AND CRITERIA
DIVISION KINDERGARTEN FESTIVAL OF TALENTS
December 7, 2017

1. The contest categories are as follows:

CATEGORY	NUMBER OF PARTICIPANTS
Story Telling	1
Nursery Rhyme	1
Vocal Solo	1
Duet	2
Drawing	1
Numeracy	1
Chamber Theater	Minimum of 5 and Maximum of 10
Creative Dance	Minimum of 5 and Maximum of 10

2. **For All Contests**

- a. The participants of this competition should be currently enrolled Kindergarten pupils in public/private schools.
- b. Only District champions per category are qualified to join the contest.
- c. A contestant is allowed to participate in only one category.
- d. There will be a common theme for the drawing while the vocal solo, nursery rhyme recitation and storytelling, the contestants are given freedom to choose their own piece.
- d. Electronic backdrop, fire emitting devices, fire crackers, smoke / smoke machine and or dry ice are not allowed.
- f. Mechanics in the conduct of the contest per category should be followed strictly.
- g. The panel of judges shall be composed of a chairman and two members. Decision of the panel of judges is final. Protests shall not be entertained.

3. **Mechanics and Criteria of the Contest**

3.1 Vocal Solo Competition

- 1. Each contestant is free to choose any O.P.M. song suited to children.
- 2. Minus one music should be used as accompaniment.

3.2 Nursery Rhyme

- 1. Each contestant will recite a nursery rhyme in Mother Tongue.
- 2. The contestant is free to choose any rhyme suited to his/her age.
- 3. The delivery of the piece should not exceed 3 minutes.

CRITERIA:

Voice clarity and projection	-	25%
Diction	-	20%
Interpretation	-	25%
Mastery	-	25%
Costume	-	5%
TOTAL	-	100%

3.3 Storytelling Through Picture

1. Each contestant is free to choose any mother tongue story to tell suited to his/her level.
2. The contestant shall use pictures to tell stories.
3. Vocal expression and proper phrasing shall be given emphasis.
4. The delivery of the story will not exceed 3 minutes.

3.4 Drawing

1. Each contestant will draw on one sheet of Oslo Paper using crayons within 1 hour.
2. Each contestant will provide his/her drawing materials to be used during the contest.
3. The drawing depicts the theme which is "Healthy Surroundings"

3.5 Creative Dance Competition

1. The group is composed of 5 to 10 participants.
2. Each participating group will create a dance depicting a certain sport of their choice. Example, if they choose basketball, their steps will include dribbling, shooting, throwing and catching.
3. Time of performance should not exceed 5 minutes including entrance and exit.
4. Props should be naturally placed on stage during the performance.

3.6 Chamber Theater

1. The group is composed of 5 to 10 participants.
2. Each group will be given a maximum of five (5) minutes including entrance and exit to perform.
3. The winners will be chosen by the panel of judges based on the following criteria:

3.7 Duet Competition

1. Each contestant is free to choose any song provided it is appropriate for children.
2. Performance time is 2-3 minutes including entrance and exit.
3. Minus-one music or live piano or guitar can be used without accompaniment; however, contestants are allowed to sing without accompaniment.
