**2018 FILIPINO VALUES MONTH CULMINATION PROGRAM**

TO : Public Schools District Supervisors  
Elementary and Secondary School Heads  
District ESP Coordinators (Elementary and Secondary)

1. Pursuant to Proclamation No. 479 signed by the Former President Fidel V. Ramos on October 7, 1994, November shall be the Filipino Values Month. According to this proclamation, the celebration of the Filipino Values Month is a desirable and effective measure to create moral awakening and national consciousness on human values that are unique, genuine, and positively Filipino. In this connection, the Division of Kabankalan City shall conduct the 2018 Filipino Values Month Culmination Program on November 29, 2018 with a theme "Pagkakapantay-pantay: Pinahalagahan sa EsP" at the Division Conference Hall. The highlights of the culmination program are the Tagis-Talino, Sayawit, and on-the-spot Poster making contests both in the elementary and secondary level.
2. The activity aims to:
  - a. enhance the innovativeness or creativity among EsP learners in the division through the competitions.
  - b. foster the value of unity, sportsmanship, and camaraderie among the contestants;
  - c. re-orient the District EsP Coordinators and coaches about the goals of EsP instruction.

3. Participants to this program will be the District EsP Coordinators, coaches and contestants to the different contests at the Division Level distributed as follows:

5. The mechanics, guidelines and criteria in judging the different contests are enclosed to this memorandum.

## CRITERIA, MECHANICS, AND RULES OF THE CONTESTS

### A. TAGIS-TALINO

1. Each district will form a team composed of three (3) members per team.
2. The teams will compete in the Easy, Average, and Difficult categories.
3. There will be ten (10) questions per category that relate to the contents of EsP 4-6 in the elementary, and EsP 7-10 in the secondary.
4. Easy questions will have 1 point each, Average questions 3 points each, and Difficult questions 5 points each.
5. The quizmaster will read the question twice and the team will be given a maximum of 15 seconds to write the answer on the answer sheet, then wait for the quizmaster's signal to raise their answer. The scorers will check the answers and tally the scores on the scoresheet/scoreboard.
6. The teams within the top three scores will be declared as the winners: Champion, 1<sup>st</sup> runner-up, and 2<sup>nd</sup> runner-up, respectively.
7. In case of a tie, the quizmaster will read one question at a time from the Clincher items. The team **which can give the correct answer first will be automatically declared as the winner.**

### B. SAYAWIT

1. Sayawit presentations must be value-laden, most preferably, be relevant to theme.
2. Presentation time should not exceed ten (10) minutes, excluding the entrance, exit, and other preparations on the stage.
3. The number of performers on stage should be from 7 – 10 (singers and dancers) including technical assistants.
4. Props, costume, and other stage sets are optional.
5. **The performers may present with or without accompaniment.**
6. The criteria for judging sayawit are the following:

❖ Value presented/relevance to the theme	-	35%
❖ Choreography	-	25%
❖ Mastery	-	30%
❖ Over-all impact	-	10%

### C. ON-THE-SPOT POSTER-MAKING CONTEST

1. Contestants must bring their own materials such as the following:
  - ✎ *¼ illustration board*
  - ✎ *Pencil*
  - ✎ *Coloring material*
2. Contestants are given two hours to finish their work.
3. Letterings and borders are discouraged to be part of the presentation.
4. The following are the criteria for judging the poster-making contest:

✎ Relevance to the theme/ value	-	40%
✎ Creativity	-	25%
✎ Originality	-	20%
✎ Visual Impact	-	15%
