DIVISION MEMORANDUM

**PARTICIPATION OF SDO, KABANKALAN CITY TO THE
2018 PALARONG PANLALAWIGAN**

1. The Schools Division Office of Kabankalan City will participate in the 2018 Palarong Panlalawigan on December 16 to 21, 2018 at the Pana-ad Park and Stadium, Barangay Mansilingan, Bacolod City with the theme: "Sports: Building Unity, Producing Champions".
 2. The objectives of the Palarong Panlalawigan are to:
 - a. promote Physical Education (PE) and Sports as an integral part of Basic Education for the holistic development of the youth to become responsible and globally competitive citizens of the country;
 - b. inculcate in their minds the spirit of discipline, teamwork, excellence, fair play, solidarity, sportsmanship, and other values inherent in sports;
 - c. promote and achieve peace by means of sports;
 - d. select best athletes to represent the province in the upcoming WVRAA Meet.
 3. The Palarong Panlalawigan shall be participated by the ten (10) area delegations namely: Area I, II, III, IV, V, VI, VII (Bacolod City Division), VIII (NOPSSSCEA), IX (NOHS), and X (ANOPSSAI).
 4. The sports events including demonstration sports and Paralympics played in the previous 2018 Palarong Pambansa with its related general and technical guidelines shall remain in effect unless otherwise amended, modified or revised.
 5. Delegations must adhere to the provision of DepEd Order No. 40, s. 2012 entitled "DepEd Child Protection Policy. As such, all delegation officials shall be held responsible for the protection, welfare and safety of their pupil/student-athletes.
 6. Kabankalan City athletic delegation shall depart for the Provincial Meet on December 15, 2018 at 9:00 AM. The committees for Food and Billeting shall depart on December 14, 2018 at 10:00AM to prepare the kitchen and billeting of our delegates.
 7. First meal to be served will be Lunch of December 15, 2018.
 8. Kabankalan City and the rest of AREA VI delegates shall be billeted at Rizal Elementary School, Bacolod City.
 9. All coaches and technical officials are required to attend the Solidarity Meeting, Parade and Opening Program. Solidarity meeting is on December 16, at 8:00 in the Morning at the Negros Occidental High School (NOHS) Quadrangle, while Parade and Opening program will start at 2:00 in the afternoon at the Pana-ad park and Stadium. Assembly Area for the Parade is outside of the Stadium in front of the swimming pool.

10. Welcome lunch will be served on December 16, 2018. Supervisors, school heads and non-teaching personnel are invited to the welcome lunch and to join the parade.
11. All officiating officials are required to present an approved authority to travel document duly signed by their respective head of office, and medical certificate from government physician certifying the he/she is physically fit and able to serve during the meet.
12. Technical officials in athletics and swimming are advised to bring stop watch. Each Chess team is required to bring one (1) chess clock and one (1) chess board during the competition. Likewise, each Taekwondo team is advised to bring sensing socks for kyorugi competition.
13. All officiating officials, coaches, chaperons and trainers are expected to observe the code of conduct and proper decorum at all times and served as role models to the athletes. Any unsportsmanlike conduct of coaches and officials shall be ground for suspension, disqualification or administrative sanction.
14. The Clean, Green and Eco-Friendly Policy which is being implemented during the Palarong Pambansa shall be enjoined and adhered to.
15. Consistent with DepEd's existing policies and guidelines in resolving protest on game technicalities of any sports event and protest on eligibility, compliant should be in written form duly signed by the coach and noted by the head of delegation. A complaint shall be accompanied by affidavit of witnesses and/or evidence to supports the same and shall be filed before the start of the next game of the concerned team.
16. Other information relative to the participation of Kabankalan delegates to this meet are stipulated in the hereto-attached enclosures.

17. Coaches and athletes shall bring with them eating utensils, sets of bedding, and personal effects good for the entire duration of the meet.
18. Travel expenses incurred relative to the attendance to the 2018 Palarong Panlalawigan shall be chargeable against local funds / MOOE subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
19. Wide dissemination and compliance to this Memorandum is highly desired.
