SCHOOL-BASED MEASLES' IMMUNIZATION OF

**UNIMMUNIZED GRADES 1 AND 7 LEARNERS** 

- 1. Due to the rising cases of measles in the Philippines with the Department of Health (DOH) declaring outbreaks in several areas including Western Visayas, the Schools Division Office of Kabankalan City supports the urgency to immunize the unimmunized Grades 1 and & 7 learners in all schools.
- 2. In partnership with the Department of Health Region 6 and Kabankalan City Health Office, measles immunization and Vitamin A supplementation program shall be conducted from February until end of March 2019.
- All school heads are hereby directed to immediately secure the parental
  consent of identified unimmunized learners and are expected to provide
  assistance to the City Health personnel while the above-mentioned activity is
  being conducted.
- 4. Personnel of the Health and Nutrition Unit shall take the lead and monitor in the prompt implementation of the program.
- 5. Immediate dissemination of this memorandum is desired.

## SCHOOL-BASED MEASLES IMMUNIZATION OF UNIMMUNIZED GRADES 1 AND 7 LEARNERS

To: Schools Division Superintendents

- 1. Due to the recent declaration of Measles outbreak in Western Visayas, there is an urgent need to immunize the unimmunized Grades I and 7 learners in all schools.
- 2. In partnership with the Department of Health Region 6, a measles vaccination and Vitamin A supplementation program shall be conducted from February to end of March 2019.
- 3. Immediate parental consent shall be secured for identified unimmunized learners.
- 4. All doctors, nurses, and staff of the Health and Nutrition Units shall take the lead in the prompt implementation of the program in their respective Divisions.
- 5. Immediate and widest dissemination of this memorandum is hereby directed.
