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

**ADMINISTRATION OF THE BASIC EDUCATION EXIT ASSESSMENT FOR SCHOOL YEAR 2017-2018**

To: Chiefs, CID and SGOD  
Public Schools District Supervisors  
Public and Private Elementary & Secondary School Heads  
All Other Concerned

1. As per DepEd Memorandum No. 014, s. 2018, the **ADMINISTRATION OF THE BASIC EDUCATION EXIT ASSESSMENT FOR SCHOOL YEAR 2017-2018**, the Department of Education (DepEd), through the Bureau of Education Assessment (BEA) with the assistance of schools division and secondary schools personnel shall administer the **Basic Education Exit Assessment (BEEA) for the School Year (SY) 2017-2018 on March 10, 2018 to all Grade 12 students in both public and private schools nationwide.**
2. In SY 2016-2017, the Philippines has implemented for the first time the Senior High School (SHS) Curriculum in its K to 12 Basic Education Program. This SY, 2017-2018, the first batch of students in the SHS program is expected to graduate meeting the content and performance standard of 21<sup>st</sup> century skills such as Problem Solving, Information Literacy, and Critical Thinking Skills embedded in eight core subject areas, namely:
  - a. Language and Communication;
  - b. Wika at Komunikasyon;
  - c. Humanities;
  - d. Media and Information Technology;
  - e. Mathematics;
  - f. Science;
  - g. Social Science and personal Development; and
  - h. Philosophy.
3. The BEEA aims to:
  - a. Determine students' learning progress and their attainment of the learning standards;
  - b. Help provide information to improve instructional practices;
  - c. **Assess the effectiveness and efficiency of education service delivery**
  - d. **Provide empirical information as basis for the improvement of the curriculum, learning delivery, assessment, and for policy review and formulation.**
