SUBJECT:

SUBMISSION OF PUBLIC AND PRIVATE SCHOOLS ANTI-BULLYING POLICIES

AND REPORTS ON BULLYING INCIDENTS AND CASES

- 1. Pursuant to R.A. 10627 otherwise known as the Anti-Bullying Act of 2012 and Rule VI of its IRR, the Office of the Undersecretary for Legislative Affairs, External Partnerships and School Sports issued Memo OULAPPS No. 61, s. 2019 and the Office of the Regional Director issued Regional Memo No. 073, s. 2019.
- 2. All private and public elementary and secondary schools are required to submit a hard copy (2 copies) of **Child protection or anti-bullying policies** to the Schools Division Office of Kabankalan City, as required under Section 3 of RA 10627 and Rule VI, Section 8.4 (A) of its IRR;
- 3. The aforementioned are also required to submit to the School Division Office the Latest Reports on relevant information and statistics on bullying and retaliation and the Updated List of Child Protection Committees (CPC) for each schools.
- 4. Section 14, Rule 7 of IRR of RA 10627 provides for sanctions for non-compliance. Failure to comply with the provisions of the Act or its IRR shall be subject to administrative disciplinary proceedings in accordance with the CSC and other relevant issuances of DepEd.
- 5. The Child protection or anti-bullying policies, Reports on relevant information and statistics on bullying and retaliation and List of Child Protection Committees should be submitted on or before March 15, 2019.
  - 6. Widest dissemination and compliance of this memorandum is desired.

## Section 10 of Department Order No. 20, s. 2012

#### **ESTABLISHMENT OF CHILD PROTECTION COMMITTEE**

All public and private elementary and secondary schools shall establish a Child Protection Committee (CPC)

### The CPC shall be composed of the following:

- 1. School Head/Administrator Chairperson
- 2. Guidance Counselor/Teacher Vice Chairperson
- 3. Representative of the Teachers as designated by the Faculty Club
- 4. Representative of the Parents as designated by the Parents-Teachers Association
- 5. Representative of pupils, students and learners as designated by the Supreme Student Council
- 6. Representative from the Community as designated by the Punong Barangay, preferably a member of the Barangay Council for the Protection of Children (BCPC)
