Subject: REGIONAL AND DIVISION BRIGADA ESKWELA IMPLEMENTATION

1. Pursuant to DepEd Memorandum 66, s. 2018, the Schools Division Office of Kabankalan City will conduct Brigada Eskwela from May 28 to June 2, 2018 with the theme: *Pagkakaisa para sa Handa, Ligtas at Matatag na Paaralan Tungo sa Magandang Kinabukasan.*
2. The Regional Kick-Off will be on May 25 at Gil Montilla National High School, Sipalay City. Participants are CID, SGOD and School Heads which shall wear the official Division BE Shirt (Black-round neck with BE LOGO) during the caravan. All PSDS shall coordinate the attendance of School Heads who would join the Regional Kick off. Participants will leave the Division Office at 6:00 AM.
3. The Division Kick-off Program will be on May 28 at Florentino Galang Sr. National High School, Brgy. Oringao, Kabankalan City. Program will start at 10:00 AM after the caravan.
4. Each school shall have ten (10) representatives to the Division Kick-off which is composed of the School Head, BE Coordinator, Teachers, PTA, SSG/SPG and other stakeholders.
5. Each School shall provide a vehicle to join the caravan with tarpaulin and balloons. The Caravan will start at 8:00 AM, in front of the Gabaldon Building, Schools Division Office.
6. Participants shall wear Black round shirt with the official logo of Brigada Eskwela 2018.
7. All schools are enjoined to hold a kick off program on May 29 in their own respective school campuses.

8. Schools Heads shall take the lead role in planning activities for the Brigada Eskwela. They have to submit Brigada Eskwela Action Plan in the Schools Division Office c/o Socmob on or before May 11. This is to ensure that other volunteers from the different agencies and organizations will be coordinated properly for the benefit of the school concern.
9. School Heads shall ensure the effective implementation of Brigada Eskwela through involvement of community and local stakeholders.
10. Teaching personnel are entitled to earn vacation service credits arising from their active involvement in the Brigada Eskwela activity. A complete six-day participation in the maintenance effort shall give teachers a three-day service credit entitlement.

12. Expenses incurred in the participation to the Regional and Division BE Launching shall be chargeable against school/local funds or MOOE subject to usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
