Subject: **2019 Brigada Eskwela Division Kick-Off and Implementation**

1. Pursuant to DepEd Memorandum 36, S. 2019, the Schools Division Office of Kabankalan City will conduct **Brigada Eskwela** with the theme ***“Matatag na Bayan para sa Maunlad na Bayan”*** on **May 20 to 25, 2019**.
2. The Brigada Eskwela is a National School Maintenance Week that aims to bring together all education stakeholders to participate and contribute their time, effort and resources to prepare public school facilities for the opening of school year in June.
3. The Brigada Eskwela Kick-off Program will be on May 20, 2019 at Kabankalan National High School Covered Court, after a caravan to start at 7:00AM in front of the Division Office. This activity will be participated by the Division Non-Teaching Personnel, Kabankalan National High School, ERAMS - West and ERAMS -East Teachers.
4. All schools shall have a simultaneous celebration in their own respective schools. School Heads will lead the planning activities geared in making schools ecologically conscious, resilient, clean, safe and conducive to learning.
5. Brigada Eskwela action plan shall be submitted to their PSDSs and SGOD office – Soc Mob unit on or before May 10, 2019. This is to ensure that volunteers from the different agencies and organizations will be coordinated properly for the benefit of school concerns. Encode details of resources and activities to the Google Form which will be posted in the FB page of SDO Kabankalan.
6. DepEd employees and teachers are encourage to participate in Brigade Eskwela activities by volunteering their skills. Non-teaching personnel shall earn a Compensatory Time Off (CTO) for the complete eight hours participation in the maintenance efforts and the teaching personnel are entitled to earn vacation service credits. One day service credit for the accumulated eight hours participation in the maintenance effort.
7. There will be a re-orientation of Brigada Eskwela implementation on May 7, 2019 at Kabankalan National High School Covered Court. The activity will start at 9:00 AM and to be attended by School Heads/ Principals and Brigada Eskwela Coordinators.
