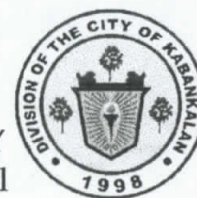



### 3rd Regional SBM-WinS Learning Exchange

To: Schools Division Superintendents

1. The Field Technical Assistance Division, this office, through the Regional SBM-WinS Technical Working Group, will conduct the **3rd Regional SBM-WinS Learning Exchange** on **October 14-16, 2019** to be hosted by the **Schools Division of Cadiz City, Negros Occidental**. This year's theme is **"Innovations: Key to Sustaining WinS Implementation"**.
2. This activity aims to provide avenue for sharing best practices on School-Based Management (SBM) - Water, Sanitation and Hygiene (WaSH) in Schools (Wins) Implementation and recognize milestones in schools and Schools Divisions. Highlighted in this year's Learning Exchange are remarkable innovations and scaling-up strategies of schools and schools divisions to sustain Wins Implementation.
3. Participants to this activity are SDSs, ASDSs, Chief ESs, Division SBM Coordinators, members of the Regional 3-Star Schools Validating Teams, members of the Division TWG (total: 8 pax per SDO), presentation reactors from different regions, selected Regional TA Team members and regional staff.
4. Moreover, in appreciation of schools' remarkable performance on WinS implementation, all region-validated three (3)-Star Schools will be recognized during the activity. Each school must send representative/s to receive their plaque and certificate of recognition.
5. Travel and other incidental expenses of identified official participants (item 3) shall be chargeable against **local funds**, their board and lodging shall be chargeable against **downloaded funds** to SDO Cadiz City, while travel and incidental expenses including the board and lodging of participants from schools (item 4) shall be chargeable against respective schools' **MOOE/local funds** all subject to the usual government accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
6. Registration starts at 8:00 AM of day 1, including the installation of booth displays depicting initiatives and best practices of schools/SDOs. Each SDO must be responsible for the materials to be used for the display booths, expenses herein shall also be charged against division MOOE. First meal to be served is breakfast of Day 1.
7. All SDOs are likewise encouraged to conduct Division SBM-WinS Learning Exchange in preparation for the above-mentioned activity.
8. Wide dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
