The contestant will be held accountable for any issues that may arise with regard to the originality and accuracy of the content;

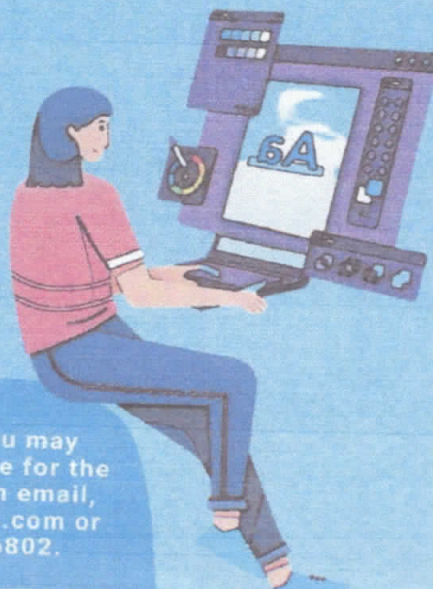
